What Do You Say? Series - Part 4: What Do You Say About Yourself?

What you say about yourself will affect your life. So, what are you saying about yourself? Find out what God's Word says about you and make that your confession.

1. Jesus repeatedly confessed who He is
 - 1.1 "I am the Bread of life" - John 6:35
 - 1.2 "I am the light of the world" - John 8:12
 - 1.3 "I am the way, the truth, and the life" - John 14:6
2. Your confession rules you
 - 2.1 "A spiritual law too few realize is: our confessions rule us." *Kenneth E. Hagin* - Proverbs 18:20-21
3. What do you say about yourself?
 - 3.1 I am a new creation – 2 Corinthians 5:17
 - 3.2 I am the righteousness of God – 2 Corinthians 5:21, Romans 6:6
 - 3.3 I am more than a conqueror – Romans 8:37 (1 John 5:4)
 - 3.4 I am a joint heir with Christ - Romans 8:16-17 (Hebrews 1:1-2, Romans 8:32)
 - 3.5 I am an ambassador of Christ – 2 Corinthians 5:20 (Mark 16:15)

Conclusion: What have you been saying about yourself? We need to realize that our confession rules our lives. Therefore, we should imitate Jesus and say the same things that God says about us. As we do, our lives will begin to change. We will overcome weaknesses, and we will enter the abundant life.
