3.3 Fill your heart with God's Word - Psalm 37:30-31

Conclusion: Be sure you use your words wisely. If you want to use your words wisely, speak words that minister grace to others; do not begin with your mouth, but with your heart. Fill your heart with God's Word, and you will use your words wisely.
