Christmas Service: Jesus Our Savior

Jesus came into this world to save the world. Jesus said in Luke 19:10, "*for the Son of Man has come to **seek** and to **save** that which was **lost**.*" Jesus is the savior! What does that mean to us today? We will focus on three words in Luke 19:10 to answer that question: seek, lost, and save.

1. What does it mean to be lost?

1.1 To be lost means to be lost in sin and to be a slave of the power of sin - Ephesians 2:1-3

1.2 People who are lost need to be saved from the power of sin that controls their lives.

2. Why and how did Jesus seek the lost?

2.1 Why: Because God loves the lost - John 3:16

2.2 How: By preaching the good news of God's Kingdom – Matthew 9:35

3 Jesus saves the lost from sin, sickness, and oppression

3.1 Jesus came to save all mankind from sin - John 3:16-17

3.2 Jesus is anointed to heal you of sickness and oppression - Acts 10:38

4 How do you receive salvation?

4.1 Believe the good news of Jesus and invite Him into your heart to be your savior – Romans 10:9-10

Conclusion: Jesus came to save you from sin, sickness, and oppression. Today, you can receive salvation, healing, and freedom by faith in Jesus.
