- 1. Delight yourself in the Lord Psalm 37:4
 - 1.1 To delight yourself in the Lord means that you desire God more than anything else. Your greatest joy in life is your relationship and walk with God. It means you want to live in His plan for your life.
 - 1.2 To delight yourself in the Lord also means to delight in His will (Psalm 40:8) and His Word (Psalm 119:47).
 - 1.3 When you delight in the Lord, God gives you the desires of your heart Psalm 37:41.3.1 Philippians 2:13 God creates His desires in us

 - 1.3.2 Isa. 58:13-14 Turn from your desires to God's desires.
- 2 David's insights in how to delight yourself in the Lord Psalm 37:1-11
 - 2.1 Psalm 37:1-2, 7: Do not compare yourself or what you have with the world.
 - 2.2 Psalm 37:3: Trust in the Lord and do good.
 - 2.3 Psalm 37:5: Commit your way to the Lord.
 - 2.4 Psalm 37:11: Be humble before the Lord.
