Part 1: A Successful Prayer Life is Built Upon the Word

Jesus taught that a successful prayer life must be built on the Word. Our prayers will be fruitful when our prayers are based on the Word.

- 1 Whether our prayers are answered depends more on us than on God John 15:7
 - 1.1 Abiding in Jesus helps to build a successful prayer life John 15:7
 - 1.1.1 Abide means to dwell, remain, and continue in.
 - 1.1.2 To abide in Jesus means to continue in His teachings, in His Words 1 John 2:24, 1 John 3:24
 - 1.2 The Word abiding in you helps to build a successful prayer life John 15:7
 - 1.2.1 If you do not know the Word of God, you are at a disadvantage.
 - 1.2.2 Put God's Word in you His Word cannot abide in you if you do not know what it says.
 - 1.2.3 If His Word abides in you, then you will have light and revelation concerning the will of God.
- 2 Four things that will happen in your prayers when the Word abides in you
 - 2.1 You will have a scriptural foundation for your prayers Matthew 7:24-25
 - 2.2 You will desire the correct things John 15:7
 - 2.3 You will not pray unnecessary prayers 2 Corinthians 6:14
 - 2.4 You will pray according to God's will 1 John 5:14-15

<u>Conclusion:</u> Jesus taught that a successful prayer life is built upon the Word. We build our prayer life upon the Word by abiding in the teachings of Jesus and by His Word abiding in us.
