Living by Faith - Part 7: The Law of Faith.

In this lesson, we will learn that the Bible reveals that faith is a spiritual law. Spiritual laws work the same as natural laws.

Truth to take hold of: The spiritual law of faith is speaking with our mouth what we believe in our hearts.

1. Faith is a spiritual law. Romans 3:27-28
 - 1.1 You received salvation and justification by using the law of faith.
 - 1.2 Spiritual laws are like natural laws. They work the same for everyone.
 - 1.3 Some do not understand or use the law of faith because they misunderstand God's sovereignty. Deuteronomy 30:15, 19-20, Matthew 8:13, 9:28-30.
- 2 The law of faith is speaking what we believe. 2 Corinthians 4:13
 - 2.1 We speak what we believe in our heart.
 - 2.2 Living by faith means we continually speak with our mouth what we believe in our hearts.
 - 2.3 Avoid a double confession. James 1:4-6
- 3 Christians must understand that our words have power. Proverbs 18:20-21
 - 3.1 We see the law of faith and the power of words working for the twelve spies. Numbers 13:27-31, 33, Numbers 14:2, 28

Conclusion: We must understand that God, in His sovereignty, has established the spiritual law of faith that will work the same for everyone. The law of faith is: we believe, therefore we speak. Remember, your words have power. It is not the sovereignty of God that will determine if you walk in victory and the blessings of God. It is when we use the law of faith and the power of our words.
